

Growing costs have displaced many Lawrenceville residents.


COMMUNITY DEMOGRAPHICS & NEED


- Steady population of 10,000 from 2010–2020
- 61% decrease in children under 18 and
 7% decrease in adults over 60 from 2010–2020
- By 2020, 40% of Lawrenceville residents are aged 25-34, nearly twice the city average of 22%

in white population







HOUSING

- 96% of units are occupied, with occupancy slightly higher in Upper Lawrenceville
- Most homes are renter occupied
- Median home sale price has increased tenfold since 2000
- Between 2011 and 2021, the number of units accepting Housing Choice Vouchers declined by 82% in Upper Lawrenceville and 62% in Lower Lawrenceville.
 The 2021 numbers for Central Lawrenceville were too low for the Housing Authority to report.

PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY

- COVID-19: Hospitalization (33) and death (3) rate lower than the city average
- Health Insurance: 6% uninsured, with lowest rate in Upper Lawrenceville
- Food Security: 16% poverty, 19% without access to a private vehicle
- Crime Rates: Declining







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
