

# Environment and mobility measures improving, but cars still prominent.

## MOBILITY

- Walk, bike, and transit scores are higher in Lawrenceville than city averages except in Open Lawrenceville (Bike and Transit)
- 40% of commuters in Lower and Central Lawrenceville do not use a car
- Declining transit ridership has not recovered from pandemic
- Less than 20% of residents live in a physical mobility
- Healthy Riders @ Lawrenceville stations (over 1.5M) surpassed 50000 rides in 2021, a 20% increase from 2020
- Agile had 17000 rides from July through

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## ENVIRONMENT

- Energy Consumption 12% decrease in Industrial and 10% decrease in residential (2019-2021)
- 60% customers were self-sufficed with suppliers that only offer a 100% renewable energy mix
- Strong levels for exceedance of federal standard index in 2020
- New Energy 6 60%, as compared to 40% city-wide
- Overstated upper Lawrenceville has trend of just 6.2 acres
