CREATING & IMPLEMENTING COMMUNITY PLANS

- Beltline Streetscape Plan** Advocated for and secured bike parking and travel amenities. Working with developers, business owners, and public officials to advance pedestrian bumpouts and other streetscape improvements.
- Green Boulevard E&P** Partnering with the city and nearby property owners to create a Park+Ride transit station with access to the Alpharetta Valley Parkway. City completed design and engineering of 20th-mile Street access, with construction slated for the fall. Securing potential connections from 20th Street to the 16th Street.
- Armed Park** Supported the city-led Armed Park Plan Update, with construction and public art planning scheduled for Summer 2022.
- Latta Park** Advocated and secured city funding for an engineering study and plan update ahead of master plan implementation.
- Clark Development Guidelines** In partnership with Lawrenceville United, developed guidelines to center community priorities in the rebranding of the newly named Clark Campus.
