CREATING & IMPLEMENTING COMMUNITY PLANS

- Better Streetscape Plan Advocated for and received City funding and Board approvals. Working with developers, business owners and public offices to enhance pedestrian footprints and other streetscape improvements.
- Better Roadsides Initiative working with the city and nearby property owners to create a more modern corridor path along the Alpharetta Valley Parkway. City completed design and engineering of three additional sections with construction anticipated this fall. Encouraging private investments from these areas to the surrounding.
- Riverwalk Park. Supported the city and Atlanta Park Plan Committee with construction and update and planning activities for Riverwalk 2020.
- Landfill Park advancement of received city funding for an engineering study and cost update around future plan implementation.
- Clark Development Guidelines in partnership with Lawrenceville United. Developed guidelines to better community growth in the redevelopment of the county-owned Clark Campus.
